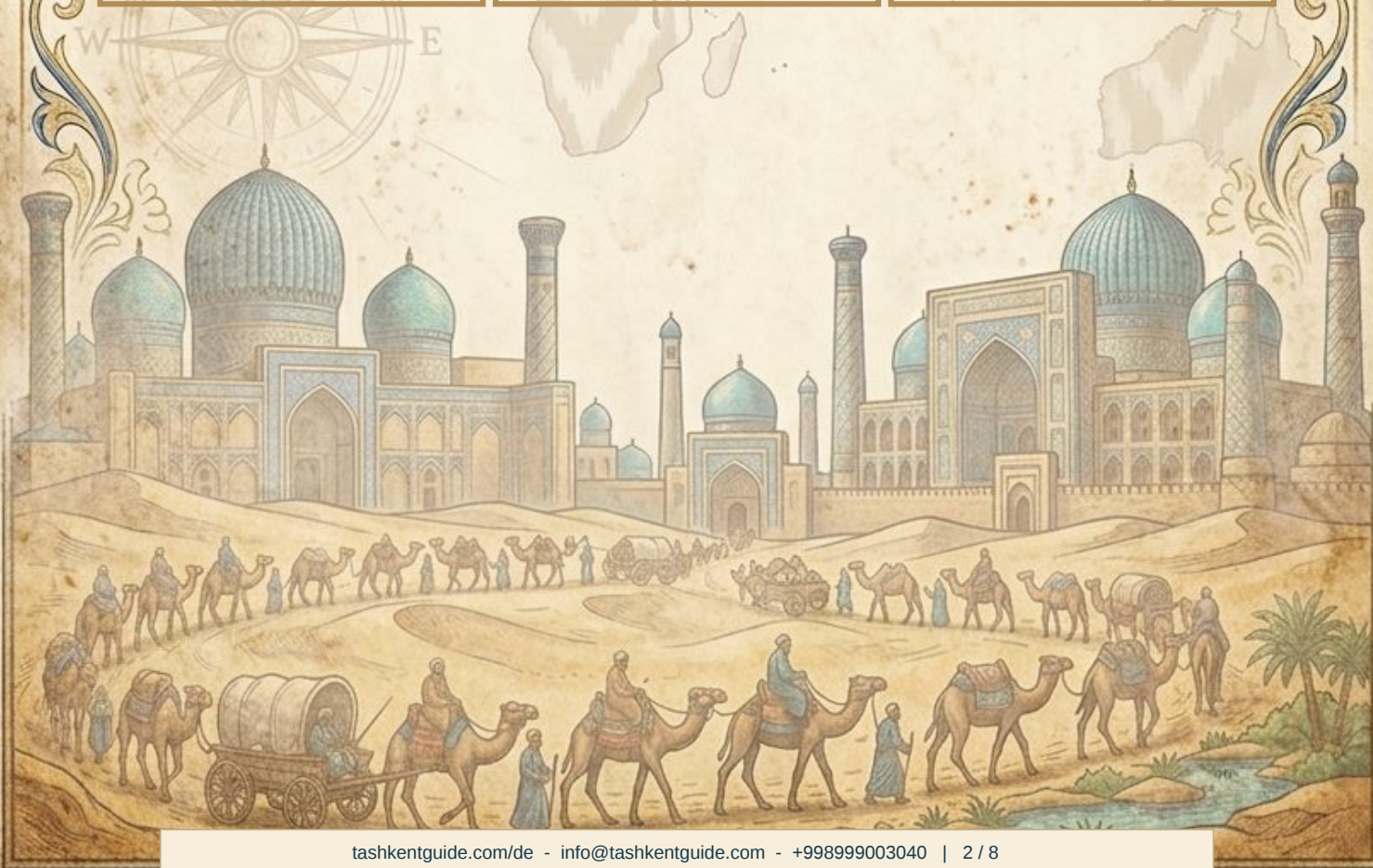
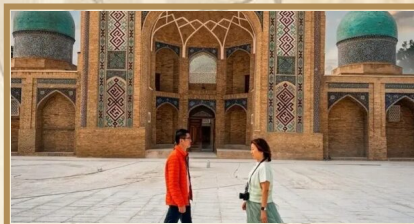
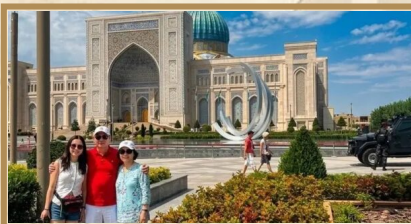

Overview

Discover old and new Tashkent in one private city and food tour. Explore the historic Hazrati Imam complex, wander through a traditional Uzbek neighbourhood, taste your way around Chorsu Bazaar, watch plov being cooked in giant cauldrons and ride the famous Tashkent metro. The tour is fully private, so we can customise it to your interests.

Itinerary

1 hour - Hazrati Imam complex and the old city

We start in the spiritual heart of Tashkent. Walk through a traditional old Uzbek neighbourhood (mahalla) and visit the mausoleum of the city's first imam, the Barakhan Madrasah with its souvenir workshops, and the Muhiy Muborak library, home to one of the world's oldest Qurans. We also see the new Centre of Islamic Civilization.





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1 hour - Chorsu Bazaar

Under the great blue dome of Chorsu Bazaar, we visit the dried fruit and spice section, the tea market and the bread market, where you can join a short masterclass and learn how to make traditional Uzbek bread. In the food bazaar you can taste a little of many local foods, and there is time to browse the souvenir shops.

1 hour - Central Asian Plov Centre

Plov (pilaf) is the national dish of Uzbekistan. At the plov centre you will see how it is cooked in huge cauldrons that feed hundreds of people at once - a true Tashkent experience and a great place for lunch.

Tashkent metro

We finish with a ride on the Tashkent metro, often called one of the most beautiful in the world. We visit three stations: Kosmonavtlar, with its space-themed design; Alisher Navoi, decorated in honour of the great poet; and Pakhtakor.

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2. Chorsu Bazaar

In Charsu Bazaar we will visit dry fruits, spices market which is located inside the huge blue dome, Then bread baking market, national sweets, open food bazaar and souvenir shops

3. Plov lunch

This is much famous for Pilov for wedding and tea house pilov and you have a chance to taste horse meat.

4. Memorial Complex

this is memorial complex of Uzbek people who gave their life for the freedom of the country

5. Tashkent TV Tower

we will look it from outside if you wish to enter inside currently entrance fee is \$4 per person and from 100 meter high you can watch Tashkent.

6. Broadway (Sayilgoh Street)

broadway is next to Amir Temur square and it is good place for 2nd hand soviet union items and painters, live music and amusement

7. Tashkent City Park

this is new park which has fountain and music, shopping malls and aquarium and lights
